There will not be a 9:00 p.m. Mass on Sundays until next semester.

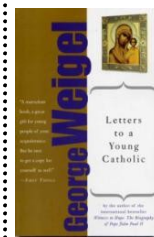
Also, there is no Daily Mass at The Catholic Center. The Daily Mass Schedule will resume when the students return in the Fall.
