## PLEASE NOTE: MASS SCHEDULE CHANGES

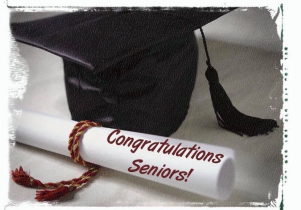
There will not be a 9:00 p.m. Mass on Sundays until next semester.
